The art of making two or three dimensional representative or abstract forms, especially by carving stone or wood or by casting metal or plaster.

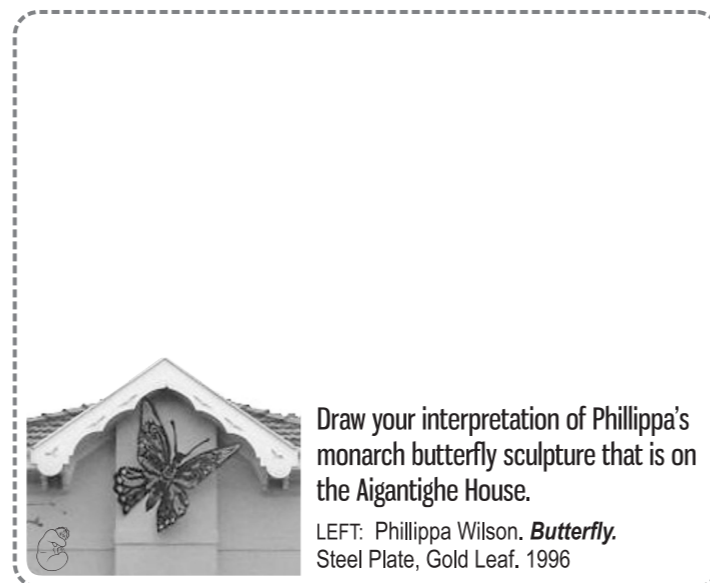

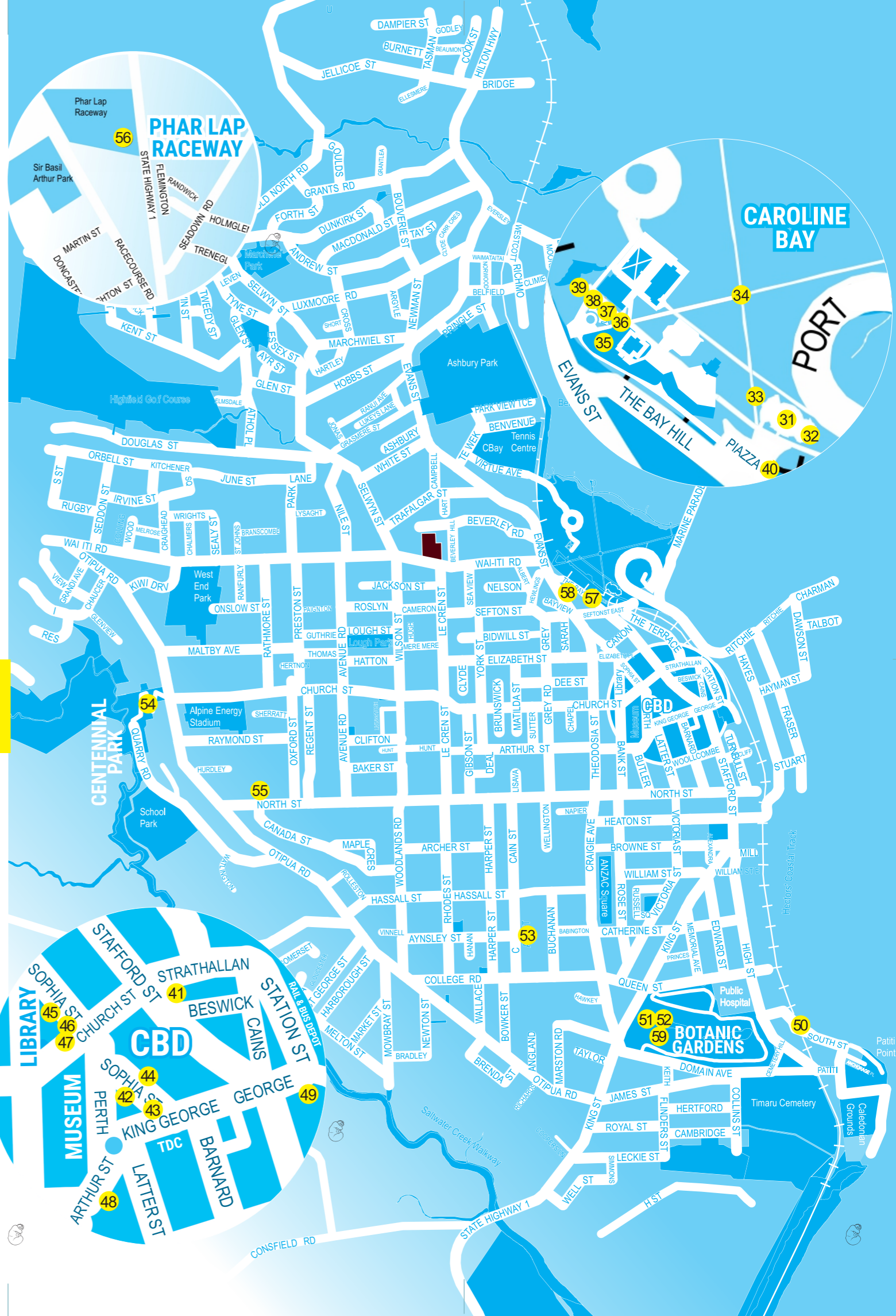
