TOP 8 TEST POTS

I find these mix well to create other shades, and contain a good amount of pigment so they are nice and thick to apply. They look their best when painted on a primed rock. *Resene test pots are for exterior use so they do not require sealing.*

NOTE: These are water clean up paints, but they will not wash out of clothes.

Any house paint will do, you'll use less test pot paint, and it will make your top coat brighter

MARKERS AND PAINT PENS



Brush
\$5 - \$25
NILON BRUSH SETS



Varnish
\$8 - \$17
Clear acrylic spray
\$55
Water clean-up paint on ClearCoat UVS
\$38
Turps clean-up Polyurethane

If you are using standard acrylic paint, please varnish them to protect the environment and little hands. If using permanent markers, spray the rock first then draw on top. If you spray last the ink can run.
